29 Palms Inn

The 29 Palms Inn was established in 1928. The Inn's owners have owned it since its inception. The owner, Jane Smith, is the third generation of her family to act as innkeepers at the 29 Palms Inn. She has been the innkeeper for more than 30 years.

The 29 Palms Inn has 20 rooms (including 9 adobe bungalows) and 3 houses. Guests can enjoy complementary coffee, homemade sweet breads, juice, toast and boiled eggs daily. The Inn has a pool, hot tub, restaurant and bar.

The restaurant's fare consists of steaks, seafood, pasta and great vegetarian dishes. Sourdough bread is baked fresh daily. Takeout, on-site catering, weddings and other on-site parties are available.

The Inn's garden, the Faultline Farm, provides fresh fruits and vegetables to supplement the restaurant. The Faultline Farm is at the same location where the indigenous Native American people did gardening in the 1800s.

The 29 Palms Inn is located on the beautiful Oasis of Mara, 72950 Inn Avenue, next to the 29 Palms Art Gallery and Old Schoolhouse Museum. The restaurant is open for meals every day but Christmas Day. Lunch is served daily except Sundays from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Brunch is served on Sundays from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Dinner is served daily from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. Friday and Saturday dinners are served until 9:30 p.m.

Trinkets & Tomes

Trinkets & Tomes is celebrating its nine-year anniversary in June. Trinkets & Tomes offers women's casual and formal wear, jewelry and accessories.

"We specialize in plus sizes," said owner Cheryl Whitmore. She especially tries to help women who bring in their own shirt or skirt and need to find a matching piece.
